1. **Minutes**  
Approval of the minutes of the meeting held on March 3, 2016.
2. **Consider recommendation(s) for LEPC membership.** Persons seeking membership to the Potter & Randall County LEPC may apply for membership. Approval of membership is at the discretion of the Potter County and Randall County Judges.
3. **Presentation and Discussion concerning hazardous materials incidents that have occurred since the last LEPC meeting:**
  - (a) HAZMAT Report: BNSF Railroad notified Amarillo of a 2,000 gallon diesel fuel spill at the BNSF Railyard; 03/21/16.
  - (b) HAZMAT Report: BNSF Railroad notified Amarillo of 2 – 30 gallon diesel fuel spill at the BNSF Railyard; 05/09/16.
  - (c) HAZMAT Report: BNSF Railroad notified Amarillo of 25 gallon diesel fuel spill at the BNSF Railyard; 05/24/16.
  - (d) HAZMAT Report: Amarillo response to an incident involving animal waste spill at I-27 and Hawthorne; 05/20/16.
4. **Presentation of the EPA LEPC Workshop to be conducted on June 2, 2016.** The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is scheduled to conduct a LEPC workshop in Amarillo on June 2, 2016. A presentation of the information presented will be conducted by LEPC members that were present.
5. **Presentation of HAZMAT-16 Full-Scale Exercise.** The Office of Emergency Management will present information on Hazmat-16 Full-Scale Exercise that was conducted on May 3, 2016.
6. **Discussion of PREMAC Regional Preparedness Conference.** The Office of Emergency Management is coordinating a community preparedness and resilience engagement that will be held in conjunction with the PREMAC Regional Preparedness Conference. Discuss the LEPC participation in the engagement activity.
7. **Presentation of Emergency Management Training Opportunities.** The Office of Emergency Management will provide information on upcoming training opportunities.
8. **Public Forum -** Interested citizens may comment on matters pertaining to policies, programs or services of the Amarillo/Potter/Randall Office of Emergency Management or this Committee that are not on this agenda.
