5. **Discussion of Community Resilience and Preparedness Engagement and the PREMAC Regional Preparedness Conference:** The Office of Emergency Management coordinated a community preparedness and resilience engagement that was held on Saturday September 9th and the PRPC held there annual PREMAC Regional Preparedness Conference on September 13th. There will be a presentation from the Office of Emergency Management regarding the event.
