4. **Discussion of taking an All-Hazards Approach to the LEPC:** The Office of Emergency Management is beginning to transition to the Emergency Management Accreditation Program (EMAP). Chip Orton will explain the process and give details on how the LEPC will be able to support the transition.
5. **Discussion of Amarillo Area Office of Emergency Management Plan Updates:** The Office of Emergency Management will discuss their concept of updating the Emergency Operations Plan and other plans in the next year.
6. **Discussion of the 2018 Airport Full-Scale Exercise:** The Office of Emergency Management coordinated with Rick Husband Amarillo International Airport for the 2018 Airport Full-Scale Exercise. Chip Orton will give a follow-up briefing on the exercise.
7. **Discussion of the Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan (MYTEP) for OEM:** The Office of Emergency Management has submitted a 3-year exercise plan as required by the State. Chip Orton will discuss and comments will be welcomed.
