 - 9/15/18 6" Poly line hit by Fiber Optic boring. Level 2 HazMat was declared with suspected leakage into the sewer line. A 7 block area was evacuated.
- **4.** <u>CERT Program:</u> Kickoff meeting will be Thursday, November 8th, 2018 from 6-7PM in the EOC.
- 5. <u>Discussion of Amarillo Area OEM Plan Updates:</u> The review and revision process has begun on Pantex-specific plans. These include the Reception Center Standard Operating Guideline, Annex D Radiological Protection, and Annex W Pantex Response Plan.
- 6. <u>Discussion of the NUWAIX-19 Full-Scale Federal Exercise:</u> The Office of Emergency Management will participate in a Full-scale Federal Exercise on April 24, 2019. This will involve various Federal, State, and local agencies. The City of Amarillo will participate by standing up the Reception Center (real-time) and evaluate the time required to respond to and stand up the Reception Center and to be prepared to receive displaced individuals. Time will begin at activation and end when all staff are at ready to receive and begin processing individuals for radiation monitoring and decontamination. No monitoring or decontamination activities are planned.
