The meeting was called to order by Kevin Starbuck, LEPC Chairman.

- Item 1:** Minutes from the March 2, 2012 meeting were presented. Rusty Dillon moved to accept the minutes as presented. Motion seconded and passed.
- Item 2:** Rusty Dillon made a motion to accept Jerrie Coleman and David Ferril as members of the LEPC. Motion was seconded and passed.
- Item 3:** Hazardous materials events which occurred since the last meeting were reviewed with a request for follow up as to the disposition of one item.
- Item 4:** Received a report on the activities of Business Connection and the New Mexico LEPC Conference.
- Item 5:** CAMEO, Tier II and RM information was made available to emergency response agencies. A report was received on the BNSF exercise and training. A tour of the Excel Energy Harrington Station prompted a request for the LEPC to tour the facility at a future meeting. Received a report on the EPA inspection of the Carson County Pump Station. The annual safety presentation of 811 Call Before You Dig will be June 27, 2012. The Chairman presented a letter on the proper procedure for reporting spills and releases to the LEPC. Linda Kelly made a motion to mail the letter to dispatchers and response agencies. Motion was seconded and carried. A Freeway Incident Management Course was offered to the LEPC. The membership requested a review to establish a path forward at the next meeting.
- Item 6:** Tiffany Pulliam from TxDOT gave a presentation on the improvements to be made on Loop 335, I-40, and I-27.
- Item 7:** An open discussion of the LEPC mission resulted in a request for membership changes to be considered at the next meeting.
